Energy Performance Certificates in Scotland

The requirement to produce an EPC in Scotland is mandatory from the 4th January 2009 for sale and rental of domestic and non-domestic properties. Large public buildings will also be required to display an EPC from the 4th January 2009.

Elmhurst has been granted a Protocol by the Scottish Building Standards (SBS) on behalf of the Scottish Government which allows Elmhurst to accredit Commercial and Domestic Energy Assessors in Scotland. The Elmhurst Protocol allows members of the 'Elmhurst Energy Assessor Accreditation Scheme' to extend their membership to cover Scotland and is appropriate to produce EPCs for the sale and rental of commercial and domestic properties and for large public buildings.
